

ENHANCING LANDSCAPE-BASED VALUE CHAINS

The goal for enhancing landscape-based value chain is to minimize ecological footprints and enhance the livelihoods and enterprises of producers in Nagaland. This will lead to economic transformation, sustainable livelihoods, improvement in forest cover, increase in income of producers, forest and livestock-dependent communities, vulnerable groups along with women and youth, local artisans, business enterprises, and entrepreneurs.



PROJECT INTERVENTIONS:

1. Value Chain Development for Non Timber Forest Produces / High Value Forest Produces (NTFPs / HVFPs, Honey, Mushroom, etc).
2. Value Chain development in Agro-Forestry (Fruit and Vegetable processing, Coffee cultivation, etc).
3. Value Chain Development in Livestock.

KEY OBJECTIVES:

1. Provide support for creating entrepreneurship opportunities.
2. Provide support for the promotion of establishment of processing units and market linkage for HVFPs, bio-resources, agriculture, and allied activities.
3. Promotion of value chain development for climate resilient NTFPs that incentivize communities to maintain tree cover and discourage short rotation jhum.
4. Support studies, trainings, grants for innovation, outreach activities, and equipment for the development of sustainable value chain-based enterprises.
