The weights given to the Technical (T) and Financial (P) Proposals are:	As requested, the selection method by assigning 80% weightage to the technical proposal and 20% to the financial proposal will be considered. The lowest evaluated Financial Proposal (Fm) is given the maximum financial score (Sf) of 100.
